ANSI staff will review the Application documents and if determined necessary, request additional documentation.

Next, ANSI will assigned the evaluation team and request the applicants acceptance The evaluation team will review the documents and if necessary request additional information. The evaluation team will then conduct a remote evaluation

An eligibility evaluation report covering all evaluation activities is prepared by the evaluation team and submitted to the CB for review and comment.
